1940 CENSUS – WARREN COUNTY, OHIO http://goo.gl/XzZ9i

The 1940 census was enumerated in a 30 day period beginning on June 1st and recorded information as of the April 1st, 1940 census date. On April 2nd, 2012 at 9 AM, the census will be released in a digital format at 1940census archives gov. From this site, you will be able to search, browse and download individual images of the 1940 census schedules, free of charge.

Initially, the search capability will be down to the Enumeration District level. From there, you will be able to browse individual page images. Since a search by name will not be possible until the census has been indexed, we have put the 1940 enumeration districts for Warren County on line at http://goo.gl/XzZ9i along with some additional information and links regarding the census.

The Warren County Genealogical Society is excited to announce that we are joining FamilySearch, FGS and others in the 1940 Census community indexing project that will provide a free online index linked to the images of the 1940 census pages.

We will soon be sending out information on how you can help index the Warren County census pages on your own computer from the comfort of your home.

- =>XWarren County Civil War 150 Roll of Honor March, 1862: 9 died while in the service and 2 taken prisoner.
 - <u>Xwilliam Bragg</u>, Co, I, 5th OVI, died 22 Mar 1862 in a hospital at Martinsburg, WV and was buried in that town. He was a citizen of Maineville. See "<u>Death of a Soldier</u>," *Western Star (Lebanon, Ohio)*, Thursday, April 10, 1862.
 - <u>Charles Catrow/Cathrow</u>, Co A, 69th OVI, died of disease 17 Mar 1862 at Camp Chase, OH and was buried there. His mother, Nancy Catrow, filed for and received a pension based on his service (Certificate #119492).
 - **Benajah Clark, Co A, 69th OVI, died of typhoid fever 7 Mar 1862 at a General Hospital at Bardstown, KY. He was buried in Sec. 1 Site 92 at the Lebanon Kentucky National Cemetery. Mary Ann (Peterson) Clark filed for and received a widows' pension on 8 Aug 1864 at Noble County, Indiana (Certificate #32041). His minor child, Hannah Elva Clark, was also awarded a pension (Certificate #139222). The 105 page pension file may be viewed at http://www.fold3.com/image/#1|263593569.
 - **George W. Crosson* served in Co A, 12th OVI (3 months) and reenlisted in Co E, 17th OVI. He died of disease 11 Mar 1862 at Lebanon, KY and was buried in Sec. 1 Site 53 at the Lebanon Kentucky National Cemetery. His sister, Martha A. Mills, filed for a pension based on his service in July, 1892 (Application #553831). Her claim apparently was rejected as no certificate no. is listed.
 - <u>Menjamin Franklin Duke</u>, Co F, 35th OVI, died of disease 30 Mar 1862 at Nashville, TN. He was supposedly buried at the Nashville National Cemetery but no record of his burial has been found. His mother, Jemima Duke, filed for and received a pension on 22 Jul 1864 (Certificate #51833).
 - <u>Xwebster Finley</u>, Co F, 35th OVI, died of disease 30 Mar 1862. He is supposedly buried at the Nashville National Cemetery but no burial record has been found.
 - <u>John Alexander Fraser</u>, Troop C&D, 4th OVC, was captured at Jackson, TN on 8 Mar 1862 and paroled same day. He was captured again at Lexington, KY on 18 Oct 1862. The name is spelled Frazer, Frasur, or Frazier in some records. He died 2 Jun 1898 and is buried in the Lebanon Cemetery, Old Section, Lot 43-5.
 - XGeorge Gibbs, Co G, 34th OVI died of disease at Barboursville, VA about 13 Mar 1862. He is buried in the Morrow Cemetery.
 - * James Ledwell, Co C, 35th OVI died of disease 29 Mar 1862 at Lebanon, KY. He is supposedly buried in the Lebanon Kentucky National Cemetery but no burial record has been found.
 - <u>David P. Shawhan</u>, Troop C, 4th OVC, was captured at Jackson, TN and paroled the same day. He received a flesh wound near Kennesaw Mountain, GA on 22 May 1864. He died 11 Mar 1898 and is buried in the <u>Baker Cemetery</u>.
 - Xwilliam H. Warwick, Co A&D, 35th OVI, died 21 Mar 1862 at Warren County, OH. He was originally buried in the Olive Branch cemetery and later removed to Sec. H, Lot 60 at the Miami Cemetery.
