
WARREN COUNTY DEEDS ONLINE

In the April 2022 e-News, we listed the many indexes that the Warren County Records Center and Archives has available online. Did you know that you can access Deeds online, as well? Similar to the Laredo system that is available in our library, the Warren County Recorder's Office has "AVA" for online research. Start by reading and clicking Accept on the Welcome page of the Public Records Search. From there, you can enter a variety of things to start your search. If you are having trouble finding records, try just using the Book and Page numbers, as spelling can throw off some searches. You may be able to find the Book and Page numbers by checking the Indexes available on our old website (one example: http://www.wcgsoh.org/Will-Estate-EName-OCP.htm) or using online indexes at the Warren County Records Center and Archives!

Once you get the results of your search, click the line with the results to get to the document icon.



Then click the document icon to see the image of the document. Happy searching!
