# "Obituary of Edwin R. Printz.", Miami Gazette (Waynesville, OH), May 23, 1906, p. 5 col. 2

**"Edwin R. Printz** was the son of **Johan and Johanna Gulick Printz**, and was born in Butler Co., Ohio, October 12, 1825 and departed this life at the home of his sister in Waynesville, on May 15, 1906 at the ripe old age of 80 years 7 months 3 days.

"He was a soldier, having enlisted for the defense of the Union September 5, 1861, at Lebanon, Warren county, Ohio in Co. F. Reg 35 OVI. The officers were Capt. "Oliver M. Parshall and Col. Fred VanDerveer. He was discharged from the service at Camp, near Corinth, Mississippi, for disability, on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of June 1862. His record as a soldier was good.

"For many years he has lived in or near Waynesville, and since retiring from business he has been a familiar figure on our streets and in our stores and he will be missed.

"He belonged to a family of six children, only two remain, **John M. Printz**, of Oronoga, Jasper County, Missouri and **Diantha M. Adams**, of this place."

#### Notes:

 Edwin R. Printz applied for an Invalid Pension (Application #890,733) on 1 Aug 1890 which was approved under Certificate #882,794.

Edwin was admitted to the Central Branch of the National Home for Disabled Volunteer Soldiers in Dayton on 6 Jan 1890. At the time he was a 62-year-old single Carriage Maker from Waynesville, Ohio. He was discharged from the home at his request on 16 Mar 1892.

- Miami Cemetery Register of Interments lists Interment #2799 of soldier Edwin Ru\_\_\_\_\_ Printz in an unmarked grave in Section H Lot 57 on 17 May 1906. The Register of Interments lists 9 other Printz family burials in Section H Lot 57. One of the other burials was Interment #2357 of grocer Edward Rockhill Printz (1832-1900).
- The thirty-fifth Ohio Infantry (The Persimmon Regiment) was organized at Hamilton, Ohio during the months of August and September, 1861. Company A and Company F were recruited in Warren County. When organized, the regiment numbered less than 900 rank and file, of which at least 151 were from Warren County. The regiment was mustered out on 27 Sep 1964 at Chattanooga, TN.
