UNION CHURCH CEMETERY MEMORIAL DAY CELEBRATION

We extend a big thank you to WCGS member, **Bob Hackman**, who held his 10th annual Memorial Day Observance at the Union Church Cemetery. The church and cemetery are located in the Virginia Military District Survey No. 1525 located on Gum Grove Road at the corner of Fordyce Road in Washington Township. Bob, with the help of his daughter and granddaughter has worked for years as an unpaid volunteer to clean, straightened and repair over 100 grave markers. In addition, they have probed and discovered and restored close to another hundred buried stones.

The Union Church graveyard is one of the pioneer cemeteries of Warren County. The 1st log church was built at the location by the Baptists in 1811. It was later replaced by a frame structure completed in 1842 by the Methodists and finally the current structure which was built in 1883. Various denominations have used the church and graveyard through the years with the last congregation disbanding about 2007.

From page 706 of Beers 1882 History of Warren County,

"Timothy Titus donated the grounds for the Union Church and graveyard. His daughter, Rhoda Titus, was the first interred in the latter . . ."
