WARREN COUNTY GENERAL INDEX, COURT RECORDS (1803-1870)

A digitized index of 9,315 entries in the **General Index**, **Court Records** (1803-1870) is now available on the <u>Warren County Records Center and Archives</u> website. For each case, the index provides the names of the Plaintiff and the Defendant, Year, Record Type, Final Record Volume & Page and Execution Docket Volume & Page. To search the collection,

- 1 go to the County Indexes page at http://www.co.warren.oh.us/recordscenter/Indexes/Default2.aspx ,
- 2 Select Common Pleas Courts in the Department drop down box and then
- 3 Select General Index, Court Records (1803-1870) in the Index drop down box.

This will provide you with a browsable list of all cases arranged alphabetically by the 1st column "**Name of Parties.**" The sort order may be changed by clicking on the arrows at the top of each column. A Search Box is provided to limit the records displayed and looks in all of the column entries for the search term. Note that the handwriting on the original entries was often difficult to read so you are encouraged to use spelling variants to expand your search. Also note that "et al" is used when multiple parties are involved in a case. This index does not contain the names of those other parties.

This index is the latest addition to the on-line indexes provided by the Record Center and Archives that we listed in our July, 2018 newsletter. The digitization of the <u>War of 1812 Pension and Bounty Land Warrant Application Files</u>, had been on hold since they completed adding the pension files for surnames beginning with the letter **Q**. The project appears to have resumed but so far, they have only added the files for surnames beginning with **RO**. In the Ohio pensioners, they are now up to the name <u>Walter</u> **Ruble.** We did not find any additional pension files with a connection to Warren County.
