# "FINDING A GERMAN ANCESTOR'S PLACE OF ORIGIN AND SEARCHING FOR FAMILY RECORDS FROM THAT LOCATION" presented by Fred Buck.

Wednesday, October 16, 2019 beginning at 7:30 PM in the Phillippi Meeting Room, the Campus Center at the Otterbein Retirement Community, 585 N State Rte. 741 (north of Rte. 63), Lebanon. This "free" program is open to the public. No reservations are necessary.

Fred Buck first became interested in his family history at the age of 10 when he discovered several family documents hand-written in German in an old bookcase in the basement of his home on Long Island, New York. He began his serious genealogy research thirty years later after visiting several of his ancestral villages during a vacation trip to Germany. He works out of the Church of Jesus Christ Latter-Day Saints Family History Center in Montgomery, Ohio, where he serves as an un-official librarian and German-genealogy expert. He has attended the 2012 and 2018 National Genealogical Society Conferences, the 2013 and 2016 Ohio Genealogical Society Conferences and the first-ever International German Genealogy Conference in 2017. Fred has a Ph.D in Mechanical Engineering from Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute and has worked for GE Aviation in Evendale, Ohio since 1986, where he is a recognized expert in experimental heat transfer and film cooling.

## ALLEEN STEPHENSON DIGITAL NEWSPAPER PROJECT - WESTERN STAR ANALYTICS

Since the fall of 2018, our Alleen Stephenson Digital Newspaper Project, sponsored and maintained by the Warren County Genealogical Society, has provided free public access to digital images of the Western Star from 1807 through 1922 on the Ohio Memory Project. We experienced a 57% growth in visitors to the project in the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter of 2019. The site was used by 1,124 visitors in 1,799 sessions to make 31,353 page views.

Since the project went on line one year ago, 2,875 users have made 120,788 page views. We are sure that Alleen Stephenson would be thrilled with the widespread usage of this resource and we are too.

The digitization of the <u>War of 1812 Pension and Bounty Land Warrant Application Files</u>, had been on hold since they completed adding the pension files for surnames beginning with the letter **Q**. The project appears to have resumed but so far, they have only added the files for surnames beginning with **RO**. In the Ohio pensioners, they are now up to the name **Joseph W. Ross.** We did not find any pension files with a connection to Warren County.
