ALLEEN STEPHENSON DIGITAL NEWSPAPER PROJECT - WESTERN STAR ANALYTICS

Since the fall of 2018, our Alleen Stephenson Digital Newspaper Project, sponsored and maintained by the Warren County Genealogical Society, has provided free public access to digital images of the Western Star from 1807 through 1922 on the [Ohio Memory Project](#). In the 2nd quarter of 2019, the site was used by 714 visitors in 1,188 sessions to make 20,547 page views. Since the project went on line, 1,751 users have made 89,547 page views.

ASAHEL C. BATES (1790-1858) WAR OF 1812 PENSION FILE

[War of 1812 Pension and Bounty Land Warrant Application Files](#), "fold3.com, **Asahel C. Bates (30 pages)**

Asahel C. Bates and **Meekey P. Bobo** were married by Rev. **Daniel Hayden** in Hamilton County, Ohio on 16 Apr 1818. They were said to have had twelve children together. **Asahel C. Bates** died on 27 April 1858 in Mason, Warren County, Ohio. Asahel served 15 days in the US Naval Service under **Commodore Decatur**. 3rd Auditor Report of 7 Apr 1852 lists A. C. Bates as having served under **Captain Robinson** for 92 days from 9 Sep to 9 Dec 1814.

On 7 Oct 1851, **Asahel C. Bates**, aged 61, of Warren County appeared before **Eliphalet Easton**, a Notary Public in Hamilton County, Ohio to make a declaration for the purpose of obtaining Bounty Land under the Act of 1850. He declared that he volunteered at N. York City for 3 months in the fall of 1814 as a Private in the company commanded by Captain Robinson in the Independent Corps of New York Sea fencibles commanded by Commodore Decatur. He was honorably discharged at Sandy Hook, N. York in the fall of 1814 after 3 months of service. [Bounty Land Warrant No. 56176](#) for 40 acres was issued under the Act of 1850 in favor of Asahel C. Bates, Private Captain Robinson's Company New York Volunteers War of 1812. He assigned the warrant to **Jesse S. Coffin** who was issued a patent for 40 acres in Adams County, Iowa on 16 Jun 1856.

On 14 May 1855, **Asahel C. Bates** aged 54 of Warren County, made a declaration before **Milton Coulson**, J.P. for the purpose of obtaining Bounty Land under the Act of 1855. He declared that he enlisted for 3 months as private in the Company commanded by Captain Robinson in the independent Corps of Sea Fencibles commanded by Commodore Decatur and served for 14 days to defend the city and harbor of N. York. **R. H. Cunningham** of Mason, Ohio was his attorney. His declaration was witnessed by **John Welton** and **Mason Seward** of Warren County. [Bounty Land Warrant No. 51450](#) for 120 acres was issued under the Act of 1855 in favor of Asahel C. Bates, Private Captain Robinson's Company New York Militia War of 1812. He assigned the warrant to **John Edwards** who was issued a patent for 120 acres in Worth County, Missouri. on 1 Nov 1858.

On 23 Jan 1879, **Meekey P. Bates**, aged 80, of Xenia, Ohio, appeared before John Orr, Greene County Common Pleas Court Clerk, for the purpose of being placed on the pension rolls under the Act of 1878, Application No. 34528. **F. E. Arnold**, aged 54 of Xenia and **Eliza Arnold** of Xenia, Ohio, testified in support of her claim. On 5 Mar 1879, **Meekey P. Bates** was admitted to a widow's pension of \$8 per month commencing 9 Mar 1878 by Certificate #20868 dated 13 Mar 1879. She was last paid at \$8 to 4 Mar 1883 and was dropped from the pension rolls for "failure to claim pension."

ADDITIONAL COMMENT

Asahel Bates was originally buried in the old Mason Graveyard. Later he along with two infant children were reinterred in the Bates family plots (Section 1 Lots 5 & 6) at Rose Hill Cemetery (Interment #821, 822 and 823). The depression era Veteran Graves Registration Project by the WPA listed Asahel as a veteran of the War with Mexico rather than of the War of 1812. We believe that is probably an error. **Meekey Bates** was buried on 28 May 1883 (Interment #254). Her inscription on the family monument indicates that she is a native of Prince William County, Virginia. There are eight Bates family burials in these lots.

PVT. JAMES PERRINE (1773-1864) IN CAPT. DANIEL KAIN'S COMPANY OHO MILITIA

WCGS member, Roger Retallick researched our request for help in our April, 2019 eNews:

Pvt. [James Perrine](#) (1773-1864) in Capt. Daniel Kain's Company Oho Militia (20 pages)

***HELP:** I originally thought this was the James Perrine (1786-1872) buried in [Fellowship Cemetery](#) but a review of the pension file shows the James Perrine who served Capt. Kain's Company was from Clermont County. Can anyone provide information on any War of 1812 service by the James Perrine (1786-1872) who is buried in the [Fellowship Cemetery](#)?*

Roger provided us with a detailed source list for both men which is in our Perrine Vertical File in our library. Based on Roger's Research, it appears that the two men are cousins descending from the same great grandfather. No record was found that showed any military service for the James Perrine (1786-1872) buried in the [Fellowship Cemetery](#). Thanks Roger!
