## **DECEASED MEMBERS OF THE SEARS FAMILY.**

**And their Connections, Since the Origination of the Sears Reunion in 1886. – Paper read by Rev. B. F. Vaughan at Sears Family Reunion Aug. 10, 1097 [sic].**

## Celebrating Irish-American Heritage Month

### British Newspaper Archive

The British Newspaper Archive is a joint venture between the British Library and Findmypast to digitize the British Library's vast collection of newspapers. For the first time these newspapers are being made available for online research. The British Library collection is one of the largest in the World. Includes most of the papers published in the United Kingdom and its territories since 1800. This is a fabulous collection to explore.

It is possible to find immigration information, military history and vital events in these newspapers. For example, the death of one of your ancestors could be reported in their hometown newspaper in Scotland. Military reports of battles from both World War I and World II, including specific U. S. Military Units and even specific names of the soldiers. Reading about historical events gives us a better understanding of what it was like for our ancestors.

You can search by regions:

Scotland: Highland, Western Isles, Grampain, Tayside, Central, Strathclyde, Borders, Dumfries & Galloway.

Ireland: Northern Ireland, Republic of Ireland

Wales: North Wales, Mid Wales, West Wales, South Wales

England: North East, North West, Yorkshire and the Humber, East Midlands, West Midlands, East, London, South East, South West

There is an interactive map on the homepage of the British Newspaper Archive to find the region you are interested in locating.

The British Newspaper Archive is a subscription-based site. Some libraries in the US are offering this site for use inside their library. Please check with your local library.

You can search obituaries, family notices, articles and advertisements all separately.
