# => WAR OF 1812 PENSION FILES:

The digitization of War of 1812 pension files on fold3.com has resumed. This phase will cover surnames from "Moore through the letter Q. Pension files for men who served in Ohio Militia Units are now on line through the name **Jesse M. Morris**. We did not find any new pension files with a Warren County connection. We know of about 83 pension files containing 2,977 pages that have been digitized for soldiers with a connection to Warren County.
