## "With Former LHS Students in the Armed Forces", Lebanon (OH) Light, May, 1945, p. 2 col. 2

Lt. **F. D. Sommers**, former teacher at LHS visited at the high school April 25. Sommers arrived in the country recently after being held prisoner in Germany for two years. After a 60-day furlough, he will report to Miami, Fla.

Arthur McKenzie is now stationed at Sheepshead Bay, N. Y., with the Merchant Marine.

Pvt. Horace L. Palmer is now overseas. Pvt. Palmer entered the Army Nov. 22 1944, and was stationed at Camp Robinson, Ark, before going overseas.

Miss **Beth McCoy**, class of 1835, is a member of a Red Cross clubmobile unit that has been serving in Germany. She recently went through the Ahrduf slave labor camp.

Seaman 2-c Clifford Shutts is now serving in the Pacific. Seaman Shutts has been in the Navy since July, 1944.

Graduating from L. H. S., Lt. **Harvey C. Schwartz** has been a member of the 364th Fighter Group as a Mustang pilot. He shot down two Messerschmitts over Germany bringing his score to six planes.

Shopkeeper 2-c Helen Fogle, class of 1938, has arrived at Pearl Harbor with a WAVE detachment.

**Charles E. Wilson**, AOM, 3-c, graduated from advanced naval air school, Banana River, Fla. as a radar Air Bomber and received his air crew wings. He is now stationed at Jacksonville, Fla.

Ralph and Richard Newton brothers, now in the Armed Forces visited LHS May 8.

Lt. Richard Keelor, class of '39, has reported to a base on California as a bomber pilot.

Lt. Arnold Iams is reported to be ill in a Belgian hospital.

**Robert V. Hatfield**, class of '43, has been promoted to the rank of staff sergeant at Camp Blanding, Fla., where he is an instructor in the infantry.

Pvt. William Kilburn who attended LHS in 1943-44, has been serving in Germany with the 7th Army.

Three brothers who from LHS are now serving in the Army are: Pvt. **Dick Brant**, Ft. George Meade, in the infantry; **Dan Brant** in the European theatre; and Lt. **Zain Brant**, stationed at Ft. Sill, Okla.

**Robert McComas**, who attended Lebanon Schools, has received discharge from the Marines. He was wounded in the South Pacific in 1944.

A graduate of LHS in 1942, **Harold Gross** has been promoted to the rank of sergeant. Sgt. Gross is stationed at an air base in the Marianas.

MOMM James E. DeJarnette is serving in the Pacific war theatre.

Ensign James Townsley, graduate of Annapolis, is serving in the Pacific, while Pfc, Robert Townsley is stationed at Ft. Benning.

S 1-c Durwood Elbon is now Stationed at Jacksonville, Fla., while attending gunnery school.

Pvt. Karl Israel has been with the Army in Germany.

S1-c Robert Wolfe is now stationed in the Pacific Area.

Lt. **Bruce Ralston**, Corps of Engineers, has been serving in the European war theatre since September. 1944. Recently he saw service in Germany.

Ensign Harry Ralston is now stationed at the Washington Navy yard in the Ordnance Department.

**Everett and Marvin Hazlewood** are fighting in the Armed Forces overseas. Marvin is on Luzon in the Southwest Pacific and has served 3 years. Everett is in France and has fought 4 longs years of war. We hope both boys will come back home soon.

#### Note

The Lebanon Light was the school newspaper for Lebanon High School. The above article was included in a memory book produced in 1995 for the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Class of 1945. A copy of the Memory Book was donated to the Warren County Genealogical Society by our Vice President, Debbie Osburn. Debbie's Dad, Wilbur Ritchey, was part of the Class of 1945 which graduated very near the 7 May 1945 VE day marking the end of World War II in Europe.
