It is extremely important to obtain copies of vital records for your ancestors. These can show family relationships if parents are correctly listed as well as important details such as birth, marriage, and death dates. Vital records in Warren County can be found at a few locations depending on the period you are searching and the type of record. Most of these records for Warren County, Ohio, are currently either housed at the Warren County Records Center & Archives, the Probate Court, or the Health Department. The Warren County Genealogical Society has indexed vital records in the county for the indicated dates in the WCGS Publication list. These are available for purchase in book format.

Birth Records

Governmental birth records for Warren County, Ohio, begin in 1867 and were filed in the Probate Court. The Warren County Probate Court continued to maintain births from 1867 to December 19, 1908. The registers are currently located in the Warren County Records Center & Archives. These early birth records were recorded in oversized hardbound books such that each entry spanned two pages. The information recorded varied over the course of time, but usually included: the child's name, birth date and place, parents' names and residence and the name of the person reporting the event.

Starting December 20, 1908, official state level birth certificates were required. These were issued by the Warren County Health Department with a copy sent to the Division of Vital Statistics of the Ohio Department of Health.

Corrected Birth Records: These records are created when a parent, sibling or the person themselves come to the judge and corrects some part of the original record that was incorrect. Corrections may include details for the name, sex, date, etc. This corrected record also contains additional information not always in the original record such as place of birth, parents' names (including the mother's maiden name), the parents' residence, and individual's residence. Copies of the original records are stored in the Warren County Records Center & Archives.

Late Birth Records: These records are created when an individual came to register his / her birth that was originally unrecorded or was incomplete. Some of these individuals needed proof of birth to obtain a social security number. They were required to bring witnesses such as a sibling or neighbor as proof, and other evidence to prove the event. These late birth records contain details such as place of birth, parents' names (including the mother's maiden name), the parents' residence, and individual's residence. Some copies of the original records are stored in the Warren County Records Center & Archives. A few delayed birth records are on file at the Warren County Combined Health Department and can be searched by the birth year, or alphabetically if they are not in the known birth year. Most were sent to the State of Ohio Vital Statistics office.

Assessor Birth Records: These records were recorded by each specific township from 1886-1907 and contained the same information that was recorded in the probate book. This information was reported to the Warren County Probate Court. For births, if the baby was born elsewhere (like township or county such as mother's family home) the birth was still recorded. Sometimes records may be found in the Assessors' records that are not in the probate records books.

Bible Records: Bible records are excellent sources for family information especially for events that occurred before vital statistics were recorded. For more information, including a list of families and surnames associated with bible records held at WCGS, please see the Bible Records PDF.

Cemeteries: Grave marker photos and burial or interment records can be extremely helpful in finding a birth date or year. If other records do not exist, these can be used as a substitute, or can help narrow down the search for an actual record.

Church Records: For births prior to 1867 and to narrow down the year of birth for after 1867, locating a Baptism record can be helpful. Keep in mind that not all babies were baptized right away and not all baptism records have been preserved. Please see Churches and Church Records for more information on Baptisms.

Adoptions and Name Changes: Formal adoptions prior to 1900 were not common, although they did occur. Many times, the children were placed with relatives or other families as an indenture, instead of being formally adopted. Adoptions have been indexed for Warren County up to 1917 (although we have unpublished information up to 1938). Be sure to look for name changes along with the adoption. Adoption records generally include the child's original birth name, birth parents' names, date of adoption, age of child, perhaps the situation, adoptive parents' names, and any name change for the child. These can be found either on one of the pages of the adoption record itself or in the probate record books.

The first step in acquiring an adoption record is knowing a record exists. The Warren County Probate Court General Index to Estates, Volumes 1-3 (arranged alphabetically), provide the full name, year, Book, Volume, Page, and Adoption Box Number (in Volumes 2 and 3) for adoptions and change-of-name petitions. These records can be accessed at FamilySearch and are searchable with FamilySearch Full-Text Search.
