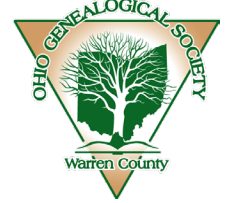

Introduction to the Library of Virginia Website

Home of the oldest permanent English settlement on the East Coast, Virginia was the birthplace of many family lines. Whether your family resided in Virginia for decades or just passed through, there may be evidence of their footsteps in the Old Dominion state. This presentation will cover the basics of navigating the Library of Virginia website for genealogical research with demonstrations of important, plus little-known, collections. All the while, I will be emphasizing what is (and is not) available for researchers due to records loss from natural disasters and men.
