Mary Margaret (Malott) Everhart (8 Dec 1930 – 10 Nov 2017)

We are saddened to report the death of Mary Malott who was an Honorary Life Member of the Warren County Genealogical Society. Many members of our lineage societies will remember Mary as our long-time lineage society chair who reviewed numerous lineage applications over the years.

In 1996, Mary published **“Peter Malott of Maryland and his descendants”** which included descendants now found in Ohio, Maryland, Missouri, Kentucky, Indiana, and elsewhere. In 2005, Mary published **“The Dumford Family”** about the descendants of Daniel Dumford and Sarah Horn of Clermont County. In addition to her family history books, Mary authored the following books for publication by the Warren County Genealogical Society.

GUSTIN FAMILY CIVIL WAR VETERANS

[Civil War](#) Veterans: [John McLain Gustin](#) (1847-1917). [William Gustin](#) (1846-1906) and [Samuel Gustin Jr.](#) (1818-1896) have been added to our list of Warren County Civil War Veterans.

[Samuel Gustin Jr.](#) was the son of Samuel Gustin Sr. and Elizabeth V. Jones. He and his family were living in Lebanon at the time of the 1850 census and had moved to Middletown in Butler County by the time of the 1860 census. His family in these census records included a John and a William Gustin of about the same age as those listed below.

[Samuel](#) enlisted in Co G, [69th Ohio Volunteer Infantry](#) on 18 Oct 1861 along with [William Gustin](#). Samuel received a disability discharge in Oct 1862. [William](#) was discharged at the end of the war on 17 Jul 1865.

On 26 Dec 1863 [Samuel](#) enlisted in Co D, [13th Ohio Volunteer Cavalry](#) along with [John McLain Gustin](#). [Samuel](#) received another disability discharge in Sep 1864. [John](#) was discharged at the end of the war on 4 July 1865.

[Samuel](#) was admitted to the National Military Home of Ohio in 1873 and remained there until his death in 1896. He was buried in the Middletown Pioneer Cemetery. A military gravestone was provided for him under a contract dated 28 Jun 1897. We do not have a photo of the stone.

[William](#) was living in Butler County at the time of the 1870 and 1880 census. He died in Cincinnati in 1906 and is buried in the Wesleyan cemetery.

[John](#) was living with the family of [Samuel](#) in Butler County at the time of the 1860, 1870 and 1880 census. He died 20 May 1917 at the home of his sister, Mrs. Althia Alexander in Dayton, Ohio and was buried 23 May 1917 at Middletown Pioneer Cemetery. John was admitted multiple times to both the Ohio Soldiers Home in Sandusky, Ohio and the National Home for Disabled Volunteer Soldiers in Montgomery County.

The digitization of War of 1812 pension files on fold3.com has resumed. This phase will cover surnames from "Moore through the letter Q. Ohio pensions are now on line through the name William Moore. We did not find any new pension files with a Warren County connection. We know of about 83 pension files containing 2,977 pages that have been digitized for soldiers with a connection to Warren County.
