Since a search by name will not be possible until the census has been indexed, we have put the 1940 enumeration districts for Warren County on line at http://goo.gl/XzZ9i along with some additional information and links regarding the census.

The Warren County Genealogical Society is pleased to join numerous national and regional organizations and societies in the community indexing project for the 1940 census. Dana Palmer has graciously volunteered to be our local administrator for the project and has developed a step by step procedure which you can follow to (1) register for an account, (2) download the indexing software and (3) join the Warren County Genealogical Society indexing group. The indexing is being done by state, so we will not have any control over which area in Ohio that we will be indexing. - =>★Warren County Civil War 150 Roll of Honor, April, 1862★ 11 dead, 11 wounded and 1 taken prisoner.

 The Battle of Shiloh occurred on 6 & 7 April 1862 with Warren County suffering numerous casualties. William Harrison Hay, K 71 OVI & John Koogle, A 12 Ill Inf, were mortally wounded. Others wounded were Thomas H. Blake, H 40 or 41 Ill Inf, George Burton, B 53 OVI, Elias P. Drake, K 71 OVI, Alexander W. Hufford, K 71 OVI, James G. Reynolds, D 24 OVI, Alexander W. Roosa, K 71 OVI, Martin V. Roosa, and K 71 OVI, John L. Trump, K 71 OVI.

 Those who died from disease or other causes included Derrick Barkalow, 75 OVI, William H. Blake, 69 OVI, Anson Brace 17 OVI, James Dedonnell 35 OVI, William H. Girton 2 Ind Cav, John P. Haggett 57 OVI, William Whitacre 17 OVI & Eli M. Williams 12 OVI.
