





There is plenty of parking and the entrance for visitors is in the front of the building. <Click>







When you reach the front, there is a set of outer doors that lead you into a vestibule. <Click> If you need it, the switch to open the door is on the left.



On the first floor to your left is a screen with a Building Directory. <Click> We are located in the Lower Level along with the Records Center & Archives.




Head for the back left corner of the lobby. <Click> That's where you will find the door to the stairs and the elevator. <Click>




Take either the stairs or the elevator down to the Lower Level. As you exit, the restrooms are directly across from the elevator, and the snack and drink machines are located to the left.

Turn left and head down the hallway... and you get to our next-door neighbor first! WooHoo! Archives!




Meet Amy at the Warren County Records Center & Archives!



Archives has cool stuff! Plan enough time to stop in and see what they have to help with your Warren County research.




From Archives, keep coming down the hall to the next tiny sign.




Take that left and go down that hallway.

If you see an open door on the left, say hello to Jacob, another Archives expert!




Maps on the wall mean you are close! <Click> You are here! Yay!





The back is a key to what is on our bookcases.






We have four computer workstations on the island in the middle; two of those have dual monitors. The extra monitors can be flipped vertically for when you are transcribing documents. There are other workstations in other parts of the library.




One of the other computer workstations is connected to our Microfilm and Fiche Reader. And yes, we still use microfilm and occasionally microfiche.




This is our wall of Funeral Home Records and Obituaries. It gets used often! We have a good number of volunteers who help keep up with current obituaries.



The large room you are in now is considered the Warren County Room. There is a smaller connected room that we call the "Rest of the World." This is where we have books covering, you guessed it, the Rest of the World! Also Biographies / Genealogies, Family Folders, Pedigree Charts and Family Group Sheets.



This is the view looking to your left and then to your right once you have entered that room. This is also a quiet place to sit if you need to concentrate.



To the right of the entrance to the Rest of the World, we have a water dispenser, both hot and cold, card catalogue (yes, we still use this), and our Vertical Files.




How Can WCGS Help You?
