Ruth Brindle Dobyns will discuss the range of Quaker attitudes toward, and involvement in, the 19th century anti-slavery movement.

WAR OF 1812 (June 18, 1812 – February 18, 1815)

Three new soldiers have been added to our Roster of Warren County Soldiers who served in the War of 1812.

*** John A. Gilmour (1794-1877) added thanks to research by WCGS member, Jim Keim. He served as a Private in Capt. James Lackey's Co, Pearson's 65th Regiment, Pennsylvania Militia See the biographical sketch that Jim has prepared regarding his 4th great grandfather.

*** William Brandenburg (1790-1875) pension file is now on line at fold3. He was drafted at Lebanon, Warren County, Ohio, in Patrick Shaw's company but instead served three months as a teamster under Jabez Phillips, wagon master, transporting supplies to St. Mary's Ohio. He was discharged at Franklin, Ohio, in April 1813. He used his own team of horses and was paid \$3 per day. William Brandenburg was granted 160 acres of bounty land (Warrant #61902) under the act of 1855. He married Mary Pierson/Pearson early in the year 1812 in Allegany County, Maryland. He was living in Washington Twp, Clinton County, Ohio when he filed for a pension (Application #2706, no Certificate #) under the act of 14 Feb 1871. His claim was rejected 19 Jun 1872 indicating that he had rendered his service as a hired teamster or civil employer. His brother, Joseph Brandenburg, was living in Warren County in 1871. In 1873, Moses D. Brandenburg was living in Clinton County. His file contains 44 documents including 1937 letters from Hazel Spencer Phillips, Bransby Farm, Springboro, Ohio.

*** Thomas Breeding (_____-1835) pension file is now on line at fold3. Thomas Breeding was enrolled in Captain William McMeans' Independent Rifle Company at Lebanon, Warren County, Ohio on the 20th day of August 1812 and was honorably discharged at Fort Wayne about 1 March, 1813, He left Fort Washington in Hamilton Co. Ohio to march to Lebanon, and from there marched to Fort Wayne via. Dayton, Ohio and was there discharged. His widow was living in Warren County in 1855 when filing for bounty land and also in 1871 when filing for a widows' pension. She died in Warren County 18 Mar 1872. Many of her pension file documents refer to Clermont Co, Ohio.

The complete pension files for James Abbott & Abraham Baker are also on line. These pension files are being digitized in alphabetical order by Fold3. They are up to the **Brien** surname for Ohio soldiers.
