War. Com. Pleas The State of Ohio Warren County Oct. Term 1828 Application for naturalization

Personally appeared in open Court John Henderson an applicant for naturalization who on being duly sworn according to Law deposeth and saith, that he is twenty eight years of age that he was born in the County of Donnegal in Ireland from whence in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifteen - being then a minor under the age of twenty one years, to wit of the age of fifteen years; he emigrated with his fathers family to the United States of America, that he now resided and has continued to resided in the United States, to wit in Warren County in the State of Ohio from the year Eighteen hundred and sixteen until the present time and the said John Henderson saith that during the time he has been a resident in the United States aforesaid, he has been attached to the principles of the Constitution of the United States and well disposed to the good order and happiness of the same: And that it has been his bona fide intention for at least three years past to become a citizen of the United States; And he further saith upon his solemn oath, that he will support the Constitution of the Unites States; And that he doth absolutely and entirely renounce & abjure all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, State of Sovereignty whatever; and particularly he renounces all allegiance & fidelity to his Majesty; The King of Great Britain and Ireland to whom has was heretofore a subject; and the said John also saith that he has never borne any heredity title or been of any of the order of nobility in any country whatever.

EDWARD MURPHY AFFIDAVIT – BIRTH OF CHARLES HOPKINS MURPHY

continued from Page 94 State of Ohio County of Montgomery

I, Edward Murphy, residing at Centerville, County of Montgomery State of Ohio, being duly sworn, deposes and says: That I am the brother of Charles Hopkins Murphy now residing at 1035 Mountain Avenue, Borough of Mountainside, Sate of New Jersey; that the said Charles Hopkins Murphy was born of my parents, Samuel Murphy and Sarah Jane Murphy, three years prior to my birth and was reared with me at my parents home at South Lebanon, Ohio, through babyhood and early childhood up to the time of the death of our mother which occurred in March, 1878, at our home at South Lebanon, and subsequently thereto for a period lived with our father, Samuel Murphy, until domestic circumstances separated the family and my brother the said Charles Hopkins Murphy, who was at that time known to me and all our friends then and subsequently as Charles Murphy, was placed in the Orphan Asylum and Children's home at Lebanon in the State of Ohio, that my brother, the said Charles Murphy, was placed in the said Home in the month of May, 1878 and was entered in that home by our father as Charles Murphy. That of my own knowledge and by all references to him by relatives and mutual friends who know ham, there was never any question that the Christian name of my said brother was any other than Charles Hopkins Murphy. It is my further understanding that the records of the said Home show the entrance therein of my said brother to be on the Homes' records of entrance as Charles Murphy.

I have been informed by my brother, the said **Charles Hopkins Murphy**, that the birth records at Lebanon Ohio, show no record of his birth there as Charles Hopkins Murphy and that the record does show record of the birth of a male child under the name of **Robespierie Murphy** on the same date and year in which my said brother was born. To my knowledge and belief there is no connection whatever between **Robespierie Murphy** and my brother, the said **Charles Hopkins Murphy**.

That at no time was my brother known to me or to any other relative or friend as Robespierie and

it is beyond my understanding how any record was ever made of my said brother **Charles Hopkins Murphy**, if such was made, as having the name of **Robespierie**; that there is no foundation in fact for applying the name to him. Sworn to before me this 26 day of October 1940
