WARREN COUNTY VIRTUAL CEMETERY PROJECT.

In the first half of 2010, we have put photos on line for over 2200 burials in <u>Bethany Church Cemetery</u>, <u>Cline Family</u> <u>Cemetery</u>, <u>Crosson Cemetery</u>, <u>Deerfield Cemetery</u>, <u>Kirby Cemetery</u>, <u>Lebanon Cemetery</u>, <u>Miami Cemetery</u>, <u>Morrow Cemetery</u>, <u>Rose Hill Cemetery</u>, <u>Springboro Cemetery</u>, <u>St. John Family Cemetery</u>, <u>Union Church Cemetery</u> and <u>Woodhill Cemetery</u>.

COUNTY LAND OWNERSHIP MAPS

We have finished indexing the owners listed for each of the townships on the 1867 Warren County Wall map. The 3572 entries have been added to the Warren County OHGenWeb project at

We have also indexed about half of the inset maps and will add the rest of these as time permits.

Ancestry.com has approximately 1,200 U.S. county land ownership atlases on line which were obtained from the Library of Congress' Geography and Maps division, covering the years 1860-1918. The original microfilms have recently been rescanned to improve image quality and legibility where possible. These maps can be searched by State, County, Year and Owner's name or browsed by atlas. The collection contains both the <u>1891 Warren County Atlas</u> and the <u>1903 Warren County Atlas</u>. The entire collection can be accessed and searched at
