### **Mexican War Veterans**

Page 311 of the Warren County edition of Hardesty's 1886 Military History of Ohio has the following entry:

"Deceased Soldiers Turtle Creek Township

"Mexican War - Matthias Drake, Nathaniel Tichenor, Samuel Mickle, John Sheets"

We found the following about these men while adding them to our Warren County Military Heritage pages.

#### Mathias Drake (1821-1864)

photo of gravestone for Matthias Drake at the Methodist Graveyard (now Pioneer Cemetery)

Bounty Land Warrant No. 5171 for 40 acres was issued under the Act of 1847 (to raise an additional military force) in favor of **Matthias C. Drake**, late a private in Captain McKiernan's Company Fifth Regiment Louisiana Volunteers. He assigned the warrant to **Frederick Stanley** who was issued a patent for 40 acres in Johnson County, Illinois on 1 Apr 1858.

Bounty Land Warrant No. 50544 for 120 acres was issued under the Act of 1855 in favor of **Mathias C. Drake**, Private, Captain McKeirnan's Company, Louisiana Volunteers, War with Mexico. He assigned the warrant to **John G. Wells** and **Thomas H. Wells** who were issued a patent for 120 acres in Nodaway County, Missouri on 11 Oct 1858.

### Nathaniel Tichenor (1826-1852)

photo of gravestone at <u>Lebanon Cemetery</u> - Interment #143 of **Nathaniel C. Tichenor** in Old Section lot 251 on 5 Oct 1852

### Samuel Mickle (ca. 1826 - before 1853)

No. 411 Samuel Mickle, age 21, gray eyes, dark hair, white complexion, 5' 6" born Clinton County, Ohio, occupation [printer?]

Enlisted 3 Apr 1847 at New Orleans by Capt. Dupern Co G Dragoons, disability discharge 4 Dec 1847

•Bounty Land Warrant No. 15323 for 160 acres was issued under the Act of 1847 in favor of William S. Mickle father and heir at law of Samuel Mickle deceased a private in Captain Dupern's Company Third Regiment United States Dragoons. He assigned the warrant to George W. Blackwell who was issued a patent for 160 acres in Douglas County, Illinois on 1 Aug 1853.

The State of Ohio Warren County Court of Common Pleas of the term of October in the year Eighteen hundred & twenty eight.

Personally appeared in open Court this 30th day of October 1828 **Joshua Lawton** who being duly sworn deposeth & saith that it is bona fide his intention to become a citizen of the United States and to renounce forever all allegiance & fidelity to any foreign prince potentate state or sovereignty whatever and particularly to the King of the United Kingdom of Great Britain & Ireland of which he is a native.
