Learn how you can access this collection of over 50,000 microfilm reels, hundreds of volumes of original newsprint, and 600,000 digitized newspaper pages. We’ll cover search strategies for locating newspaper holdings and related resources in the online collection catalog, as well as a brief overview on how to search digital content on Chronicling America (<http://chroniclingamerica.loc.gov>) and Ohio Memory (www.ohiomemory.org).

Jenni Salamon is the Coordinator for the Ohio Digital Newspaper Program at the Ohio History Connection. She has a BA in English from Ohio University and an MLIS from Kent State University. Her areas of expertise include newspaper digitization as well as traditional and digital newspaper research on various topics.

The State of Ohio Warren County Court of Common Pleas of the term of October A.D. 1828.

On this 29th day of October in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and Twenty eight Samuel White in his own person in open court, being duly sworn deposeth and Saith that it is his bona fide intention to become a citizen of the United States of America and to renounce forever all allegiance & fidelity to any foreign prince potentate State or sovereignty whatever & particularly all allegiance & fidelity to his Majesty the King of Great Britain and Ireland to whom he was heretofore a subject and further saith not.

Sworn to & subscribed in open Court this 29th Octr. 1828
