THE PERSONAL SIDE OF HOUSE HISTORY RESEARCH

Residential Genealogy can uncover interesting and, at times, rather sad facts about its occupants. While researching the previous owners of the property of a neighbor (currently known as 25 North Broadway in Lebanon), I came across the following obituary for one of its residents. From *The Western Star* (Lebanon, Ohio), Thursday, 26 Mar 1868, page 5, column 2:

Death of Mrs. Frazier

"Mrs. Mary S. Frazier, wife of Asbury Frazier, died at her residence in Lebanon, on Monday last, aged seventy years. She was born in Waynesville in the year 1798. It is believed that she was the first white female child born in what is now Warren county. At the breaking out of the last war her only surviving son, Charles Frazier, a young man about twenty-one years of age, entered the army. He was taken prisoner and died of starvation in Andersonville prison. Mrs. Frazier never recovered from the effects of this afflicting event. It so preyed upon her mind that she has at times, ever since, showed unmistakable signs of insanity."

This sad story deserved more than a quick read. Arriving at the WCGS Resource Library, Arne Trelvik was tapped to learn what information we might have and what we might learn of Charles R. Frazier. We learned Charles enlisted 9 Nov 1861 at Camp King, Kentucky, as a Private. He was mustered into H Company of the Kentucky 23rd Infantry 2 Jan 1862. Charles was listed as a POW 27 May 1864 and was held in Allatoona, Georgia, at the Andersonville Prison. He survived just five months before he expired from starvation on 27 Oct 1864 and was buried in what is now the Andersonville National Cemetery (Section H, Site 11549). There is a memorial on Find a Grave (#51154908), although it contains some conflicting information.

Mary S. (Bell) Frazier applied for a Dependent Mother's pension 5 Jun 1865 (Application No. 96686). She was awarded a pension by Certificate No. 69255.

Asbury Frazier applied for a Dependent Father's pension 2 Apr 1868 (Application No. 159493) following Mary's death 26 Mar 1868. Asbury died 25 Dec 1868 before his pension could be approved.
