WARREN COUNTY MILITARY HERITAGE http://goo.gl/uWutD => WAR OF 1812 PENSION FILES:

The digitization of War of 1812 pension files continues on fold3. This phase will cover surnames from "Moore through the letter Q. Pension files for men who served in Ohio Militia Units are now on line through the name **George Newman**. We did not note any new files with connections to Warren County. We know of about 89 pension files containing 3,127 pages that have been digitized for soldiers with a connection to Warren County.

=> WAR OF 1812 BOUNTY LAND WARRANTS:

William Dill (1788-1852)

Gravestone at Lebanon Cemetery - removed from the Presbyterian Graveyard - not listed in the Register of Interments **Beers History of Warren County**, page 735

"... William Dill, was born in Kentucky to which state his parents emigrated in 1790, and remained until 1798, when they came to Warren Co., Ohio, and settled on the farm east of Lebanon, where our subject now lives. Our subject's father was of Irish descent and was a Lieutenant in the war of 1812"

Hardesty's 1886 Military History of Ohio, Warren County Edition, page 311,

Deceased Soldiers Turtle Creek Township, War of 1812, "W. F. Dill"

Roster of Ohio Soldiers in the War of 1812, p. 40

William Dill is listed as a Lieutenant on the roll of Capt. Patrick Shaw's company which served from 8 Feb to 7 Aug 1813.

Bounty Land Warrant No. 6454 for 80 acres was issued under the Act of 1850 to William Dill, Ensign in Captain Shaw's Company, Ohio Militia War of 1812. He assigned the warrant to Andrew Young who was issued a patent for 80 acres in Jackson County, Illinois.

Jacob Vance

Roster of Ohio Soldiers in the War of 1812, p. 40

Jacob Vance is listed as a Lieutenant on the roll of Capt. Patrick Shaw's company which served from 8 Feb to 7 Aug 1813.

Bounty Land Warrant No. 11908 for 80 acres was issued under the Act of 1850 to Jacob L. Vance. Lieutenant Captain Shaw's Company Ohio Militia, War of 1812. He assigned the warrant to Graham Robertson who was issued a patent on 10 Mar 1854 for 80 acres in Warren County, Iowa

Bounty Land Warrant No. 8683 for 80 acres was issued under the Act of 1855 to Jacob L. Vance for service as Lieutenant in Capt. Shaw's Company Ohio Militia, War or 1812. He assigned the warrant to William E. Ide who was issued a patent on 1 Dec 1857 for 83.2 acres in Franklin County, Iowa.

Hannah Vance filed for a widow's pension (Application #26175, Certificate #22715) for service of Jacob L. Vance in Capt. Patrick Shaw's Company, Ohio Militia.
