The 1913 Flood in Franklin, Ohio. Elli Bambakidis & Harriet Foley, editors. 125 pages, \$18.80.

A devastating flood hit the Miami Valley from Piqua to Hamilton, Ohio. This publication provides a guide to resources available at the Harding Museum of The Franklin Area historical Society and includes reproductions of numerous captioned photos, maps and other materials to illustrate the extent of the flood damage in the Franklin area.

Warren County, Ohio Obituary Index, 2012 Edition. Arne Trelvik, editor. 388 pages, \$25.00

This is the 10th annual update of this publication indexing 91,635 obituaries dating from 1810 to 2012, has 12,211 unique surnames and more than doubles the number of obituaries indexed in the 1st edition. Each entry provides the name of the deceased, year of death and page number where the obituary may be located in our obituary collection. The collection contains 9,361 19th century obituaries.

Researching in Warren County: A guide to Genealogical Resources. Dana Palmer. 384 pages, \$25.00.

Learn about the resources available in Warren County. This book covers the basics of Warren County, Ohio research, how to find the records and details on what is available at the Warren County Genealogical Society. Included is information on vital records, census, tax lists, maps, cemeteries, funeral homes, newspapers, schools, bible records, court records, local histories, Quakers, Shakers and major repositories within the county such as libraries, historical society and other hidden gems. This book is essential to anyone with Warren County roots.

WCGS Summer Genealogy Workbook. Dana Palmer. 302 pages, \$20.00.

This is the 8th annual edition of this publication that teaches basic genealogy skills necessary to find your ancestors. Online resources, census, local records, court records, land records, publishing, English and German topics are covered. This is a great how to guide for anyone just getting started.

WCGS Cemetery Restoration Clinic Workbook. Dana Palmer. 170 pages, \$20.00.

This book was created to help researchers interested in cemetery preservation and those responsible for cemetery maintenance. Topics include basic restoration techniques, cemetery maintenance, mapping a cemetery, finding unmarked graves, mortar mixes, tombstone cleaning, tablet straightening, repairing breaks, resetting stones and obelisks and Ohio Cemetery laws.
